John 1:14-17 New Catholic Bible

14 And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us. And we saw his glory the glory as of the Father's only Son, full of grace and truth.

15 [a] John testified to him, proclaiming, "This is the one of whom I said, 'The one who comes after me ranks ahead of me because he existed before me.'"

16 From his fullness we have all received, grace upon grace.

17 For the Law was given through Moses, but grace and truth came through Jesus Christ.

Footnotes: a) *In Spirit and truth:* the *Spirit* is the Holy Spirit and the *truth* is Jesus. For he is the true Son of God.
